

Pouring a Fluid Acrylic Painting Marbleising with Lascaux.

1. Set up your materials:

- A sturdy support such as cardboard or canvas
- Lascaux Transparent varnish gloss or semi-gloss
- Lascaux Studio acrylic colour (or Perlacryl, Sirius primary acrylics or Neon)
- Disposable cups of 2 dl
- Stirrers
- Silicone oil or silicone spray
- Kitchen torch (creme brulee torch)

2. Prepare the colours

- Have all your selected colours ready
- Fill a cup to one quarter with Lascaux Transparent varnish
- Add the same amount of a selected hue to the cup
- Mix it with a bit of water until the paint is fluid but does not trickle from the stirrer
- Repeat this procedure with each of your selected hues
- Add 3 to 5 drops of silicone oil to each cup and gently stir
- Pour the cups one after another into a large beaker
- Important: Do not stir

3. Apply the paint to the support and create

- Press the support onto the beaker, hold both items and flip them over
- Let the beaker rest on the support for 1-2 minutes
- Carefully lift the beaker off and spread the paint by tilting the support
- Use the kitchen torch to gently heat the paint (10 cm distance). The silicon will surface, then the bubbles break and form cells
- Spread the paint by tilting the support to accomplish your design
- Place the painting on 4 reversed cups and let it dry in a horizontal position for 1-2 days
- Use Lascaux Transparent varnish for protection
